Award Money

The award is endowed with a sum of \in 3,000 (accepted projects will receive \in 2,000 in 2025 and a further \in 1,000 in 2026). For groups/collectives, the award sum will be increased by a total of \in 1,000.

Publication

The award includes the option of a publication, which will be edited in collaboration with the artistic director. A separate budget is available for the publication.

Exhibition / Events

The award includes a final presentation in the form of an exhibition (or in another format) and possibly accompanying events. A separate budget is available for this. After consultation, there is also the possibility of being included in Ronald Kolb's curatorial programme *Kunst als ökologische Praxis/ Art as an Ecologic Practice*.

Family-friendly Residence

M.1, the Arthur Boskamp-Stiftung's building in Hohenlockstedt, offers plenty of production space and tranquillity for concentrated artistic work. The awardees can use a furnished apartment in M.1 free of charge for up to two months by arrangement. The apartment is very family-friendly due to its size and is located on the same floor as the spacious and bright studio. Children and partners are welcome during a residency stay. Requirements

Relation to Northern Germany

Applicants must either have been born or be resident in Northern Germany (Schleswig-Holstein, Hamburg, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Bremen or Niedersachsen), or have obtained their university degree in this region, or have established a connection to this region in their previous artistic work.

Study requirements

Applicants must have completed their studies no longer than eight years prior to the application deadline. Applicants without a university degree should discuss their application in advance with the artistic director of the Arthur Boskamp Foundation. Applicants who are still studying at the time of application cannot be considered.

Visualizations (optional)

Photographs, sketches, collages or similar for visual explanation / accompaniment of the project sketch (max. two A4 pages).

Work Samples

Portfolio with materials from up to five realized artistic projects and/or a maximum of five publications of a smaller scope.

Curriculum Vitae

The cv should include a list of previous and current projects/exhibitions and funding. For group applications, a list of previous projects/exhibitions as a collective should be included, and in addition, short biographies for each group member.

The submitted materials should be combined into a single PDF file and should not exceed a total size of 15 MB.

The documents can be submitted in either German or English.
